- Secondary V Second language

If I earned a Secondary School Diploma (SSD) or Diploma of Vocational Studies (DVS) through a Continuing Education program, I must have:

- Secondary IV Mathematics
- Secondary V Language of instruction
- Secondary V Second language

And have successfully completed the prerequisite courses of the program (if applicable).


