# ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

TO BE CONSIDERED FOR ADMISSION TO A PROGRAM LEADING TO A DIPLOMA OF COLLEGE STUDIES (DCS) AT THE CÉGEP DE SEPT-ÎLES, I MUST HAVE:

A Secondary School Diploma (SSD)

#### OR

A Diploma of Vocational Studies (DVS).

I must also have successfully completed the following courses:

- Secondary IV History and Citizenship Education
- Secondary IV Science
- Secondary IV Mathematics
- Secondary V Language of Instruction
- Secondary V Second Language

If I earned a Secondary School Diploma (SSD) or Diploma of Vocational Studies (DVS) through a Continuing Education program, I must have:

- Secondary IV Mathematics
- Secondary V Language of Instruction
- Secondary V Second Language

#### AND

I must have successfully completed the prerequisite courses of the program (if applicable).

#### SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION

I may be granted conditional admission if I am missing a maximum of 6 credits to obtain a SSD or one of the three compulsory courses for a DVS. I must make up the missing credits during my first semester.

#### **APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION**

The Cégep de Sept-Îles belongs to the "Service régional d'admission au collégial de Québec" (SRACQ). Students must complete the admission form by visiting the SRACQ's website at www.sracq.qc.ca and clicking on "Admission."

#### THE ROUND SYSTEM

The round system is an efficient system designed to manage admission applications and limit the number of programs students can apply to.
